Men Behaving Dadly Afternoon Year 1

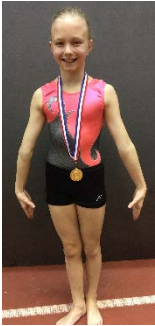

Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

Pupil Premium funding has been a valuable boost for the children. Even though all children in Reception and in Years 1 and 2 now have a free hot meal, they still may be eligible for Free School Meals and the Pupil Premium funding that will allow them to have free school meals in year groups 3 – 6. School Milk – Summer Term 2017

The price of school milk has increased to £11.50 per term. School milk is now open for payment on Parentpay. To ensure that your child's milk is ordered for the start of the Summer term, please make your payment by Monday 3 April 2017. If you require a barcoded letter, you should contact the school office in good time to meet this deadline.

Parents of children in Reception should note that there are no children who are entitled to Nursery Milk in the Summer term as all our Reception children are either 5 already or turn 5 during the term.

Fruit Shop – Summer Term 2017

We will be providing a Fruit Shop once again in the Summer Term for Years 3 to 6. The payment item is now open for payment on Parentpay. The cost is £11.80 for the full term and this represents a cost of 20p for 1 item every

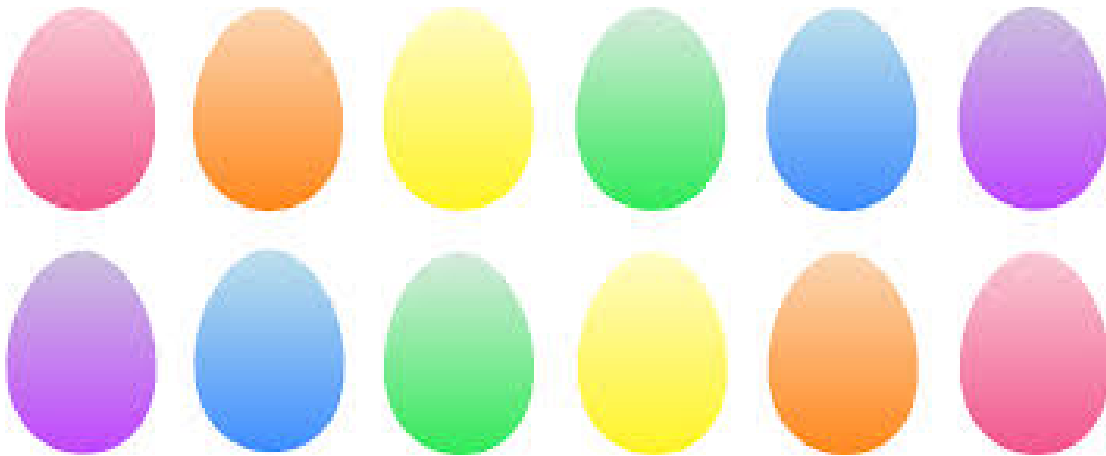
