Here are a few pictures from our four Christmas Performances this year.



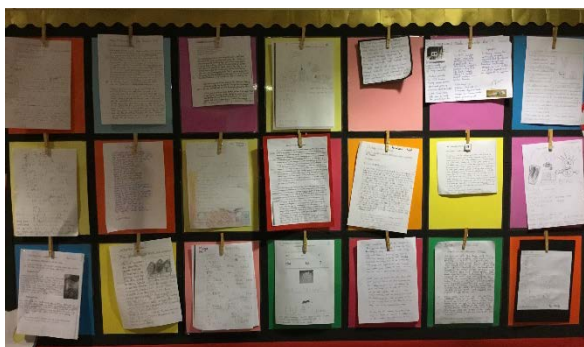


### Christmas Jumper Day
