The Organisation

Carers Trust Mid Yorkshire offers support to carer's of people who have a disability or illness regardless of age.

We provide services that respond to the needs of carers and the people they support, offering them peace of mind and understanding.

Staff

All staff are trained to a high standard including any specialised tasks necessary to meet the needs of the child they are supporting.



The Day Centre was set up to better support Children with additional needs and their families. It allows the children to mix with their peers in a safe, stimulating social environment, an opportunity usually denied to them. At the same time it gives parent/carers a short break from their caring role.

The Day Centre is held in a purpose built building at Oxfield Court, Dalton. It has excellent facilities including a large activity room with a ball pool, a music room and sensory room with a water bed.

The centre is open on Saturdays offering a 3 hour session in the morning and a 3 hour session on alternate Saturday afternoons. The centre caters for children who are 0-18 years of age and older where we can still met their needs.

All children receive a person centered assessment from ourselves, so we can understand and meet their individual needs. The service is free, so, we are reliant on securing grants and fundraising activities to keep the service going. However, it has now been running for over 25 years.
