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## After School Clubs – Autumn Term 2023

Dear Parent/Carer,

We will begin our Autumn Term programme of after school activities on **Monday, 11<sup>th</sup> September 2023**. All clubs will begin at 3.30pm and finish at 4.30pm. Attached to this letter is a comprehensive list of the scheduled clubs. Unfortunately, due to budget pressures, we are unable to fully subsidise any of our after schools clubs. **If you would like your child to attend a club, please pay on ParentPay which will be open from 5.00 pm on Monday, 19 June 2023**. Alternatively, you may request a barcoded letter from the school office. All outside clubs require children to have an outdoor kit. Gloves and a hat (woolly or sun) can also be worn. Please note that places are limited for all the clubs and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. **The maximum number of children per club will be 20 children for most clubs, with the exception of Grow Wild which will be 13, Bushcraft, Art and Origami will be 15, Science will be 18 and Hip Hop/Street Dance Years 4-6 and Drama will be 25. If a club is not showing on ParentPay, the club is full and you should return the form at the bottom of this page to the school office so your child can be placed on a waiting list. This form is for waiting lists only.** Be aware your child may not gain a place by the end of the term unless a child pulls out of a club. School reserves the right to withdraw any child who does not comply with the school behaviour policy. Pupils may enrol for as many clubs as they wish. The deadline for payment on ParentPay is **9.00 am on Friday, 7 July 2023**. **If there are not enough children interested in the clubs they will not be viable to run and will be cancelled.**

**If you have paid for a club on ParentPay, your child has a place. No other confirmation will be sent to you. Club locations and pick-up points are shown on the timetable accompanying this letter.**

**Information about our clubs:**

**Most of our clubs are £3 per session. However some club leaders charge school different rates. Prices are shown above.**

**Hip Hop/Street Dance** - Fidget Feet Dance School was founded in 2010 by Lauren Haywood. Now a team of 3, they provide fun, energetic hip hop/street dance classes and performances in and around Huddersfield. Styles such as break dancing, house and locking are taught to the children through routines and being able to freestyle. Children are encouraged to express themselves within the dance moves taught whilst gaining new skills and making new friends with the chance to showcase at the end of each block of sessions.

**Science**

These sessions will be delivered by Mini Professors, a provider whose aim is to inject fun into science. In each session they will cover a different topic from air pressure, the lungs, inventions to chemical reactions and even weird science plus lots more! They will have two hands on experiments/activities to get involved with per session, an interactive introduction, bespoke video, story and a song plus lots of fun and laughter.

**LEGO**

The LEGO club involves a mixture of moving Technic LEGO models, imaginative building using Classic LEGO bricks and other fun activities to encourage creativity, co-operation, friendship, problem-solving and teamwork.

**Origami**

Please note this will be a repeat of the summer term club. Children will be making the same items weekly.

**Signing**

This is a sign and sing club where children will learn some basic Makaton signs and fun songs to sign along to.
