We had great fun creating Stone Age cave paintings, crafting Bronze Age mirrors and drawing a model of a Bronze / Iron Age village complete with roundhouses. An exciting part was trying on some helmets and holding weapons (no one was harmed!) We completed the day by playing a strategy game called Fidchell. For health and safety reasons, we request that only one adult per child attends to avoid overcrowding and kindly ask that you enter through your child's classroom door and sign in on the sheet.


We look forward to welcoming you into the Year 2 classrooms and thank you in advance for your support.

These awards are for children who have shown they are wonderful role models and have an amazing attitude to learning - trying their best all the time.


