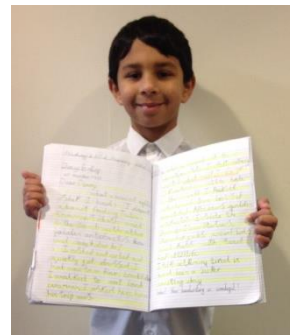






This week's Star Writer is Mohammad S for his efforts to improve his handwriting. It is much clearer and joined now.
