## Year 6 Transition Support

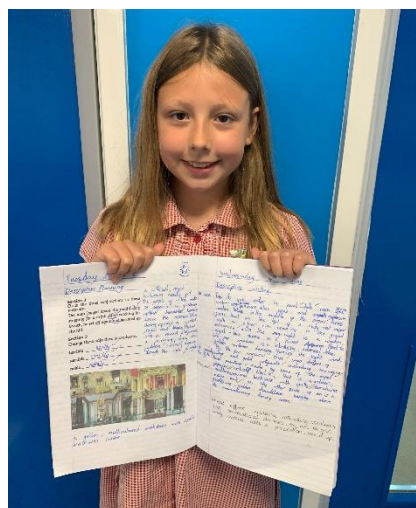
As the end of term approaches, we want to ensure our Year 6 pupils, and their families feel as supported and prepared as possible for the transition to high school.





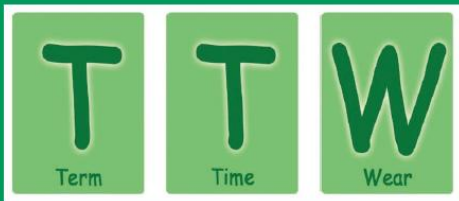
