After School Clubs Reminder – Summer Term 2026

Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to remind you that our **Summer Term After School Clubs** will begin on **Monday, 13th April 2026**. All clubs will run from **3:30 pm to 4:30 pm**. Please find attached a list of available clubs.

Due to budget constraints, we are unable to fully subsidise After School Clubs. If you would like your child to attend, please make a payment via **Arbor**, which will open at **5:00 pm on Monday, 2nd March 2026**.

We have also been made aware of an error in our Arbor Guidance sent out before half term.

Unfortunately, it is **not** possible to pre-allocate money to clubs via the Top-Up function on Arbor. Payments must be made at the time of purchase via Apple/Google Pay or by inputting your card details. If you are signing up for clubs on the Arbor Parent App, we recommend using Apple/Google Pay for ease of payment. If you are unable to use Apple/Google Pay or would prefer to sign up via the desktop Parent Portal, we recommend saving your card details to your browser so that you can pre-fill your card details.

Please be aware that as this is the first time we are running clubs on Arbor, we will send confirmation of club memberships the day after payment has been received – **please do not tell your child that they are on a club until you have been given this confirmation.**

Important Information:

- **Outdoor Clubs:** Children must bring an outdoor kit. Gloves and a woolly hat are also recommended for colder days. Sunhats and suncream are also recommended for warmer days. Due to space availability, we are unable to run outdoor clubs indoors in case of bad weather. If the weather is deemed unsuitable for the club to run as normal, the coach will run alternative activities in an indoor space.
- **Limited Places:** Club spaces are allocated on a **first-come, first-served basis**. If a club is full, it will not appear on Arbor, and you may add your child to the waiting list. However, a place is not guaranteed unless a spot becomes available. - **Club Capacity:** Most clubs have a **maximum of 20** children, except for the following:
 - **Grow Wild** – 12 children
 - **Bushcraft** – 15 children
 - **Outdoor Science** – 15 children
 - **Art** – 10 children

We will make every effort to do so but we can make no guarantees that a refund will be possible at any time.
 - **Club Viability:** If there is insufficient interest in a club, it may be cancelled.
 - **Behaviour Policy:** The school reserves the right to withdraw any child who does not comply with the behaviour policy.

Multi Sports

A fantastic club with an unfortunately vague name! Run by our sports coach Mr Cannon, Multi Sports is a great club for our younger students who want to be active but don't want to be tied down to doing the same activity every week. In this club, children are given the opportunity to try a range of sports including; football, dodgeball, tag rugby and more!

Outdoor Science

Join Miss Smith for a fun, hands-on exploration of nature! Children will head outside to investigate wildlife, discover how the natural world works, and take part in exciting experiments— including making their very own mud volcanoes. A perfect club for curious minds and outdoor adventurers!

Cheerleading

Are you ready to learn cheerleading under the trained eye of professional Huddersfield Giants coaches? Cheerleading can be an incredibly challenging sport requiring strength, team work, co-ordination and focus. In addition, jumping and stunting builds both your core and upper body strength. The sport can also

provide excellent opportunities to improve physical fitness, trust, self-confidence and interaction with other squad members.

Kirklees Music Festival Choir

After a fantastic event last year, we are thrilled to announce that we have been invited to take part again in this year's Kirklees Music Festival on Tuesday, 16th June 2026. Our Choir will be singing as part of a large children's choir from a variety of Kirklees schools. We are only able to take 30 children to this event, and places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis via Arbor (Kirklees Music Festival Choir). In order for us to learn the songs, your child will need to attend our After School Club every week. On the day of the event, the children will be taken by minibus to Huddersfield Town Hall to practise (returning before the end of school). The performance will then be in the evening. Parents/carers will need to drop off and collect their child at the Town Hall (exact times to be confirmed nearer the time) and will be able to purchase tickets for the event nearer the time. **Please only sign up if your child can attend the event on Tuesday 16th June!**

Hip Hop/Street Dance

Fidget Feet Dance School was founded in 2010 by Lauren Haywood. Now a team of 3, they provide fun, energetic hip hop/street dance classes and performances in and around Huddersfield. Styles such as break dancing, house and locking are taught to the children through routines and being able to freestyle. Children are encouraged to express themselves within the dance moves taught whilst gaining new skills and making new friends with the chance to showcase at the end of each block of sessions. Please note that moving forward this club will only run for Years 3-6.

LEGO

The LEGO club involves a mixture of moving Technic LEGO models, imaginative building using Classic LEGO bricks and other fun activities to encourage creativity, co-operation, friendship, problem-solving and teamwork.

Unscripted Media

Lights, camera, imagination! In this exciting project, pupils will work in small groups to create their very own short films from start to finish. They'll dream up story ideas, write scripts, act on camera, direct their friends, and film and edit using tablets and a green screen.

Each session is hands-on and playful, with children rotating roles so everyone gets a chance to be an actor, director, camera operator, or editor. Working together to bring their ideas to life makes the process fun, creative, and confidence-boosting. Pupils will learn how stories are told on screen, explore sound and visual effects, and develop teamwork, communication, and problem-solving skills along the way.

The project ends with a special screening where pupils proudly share their finished films and celebrate what they've created together.
