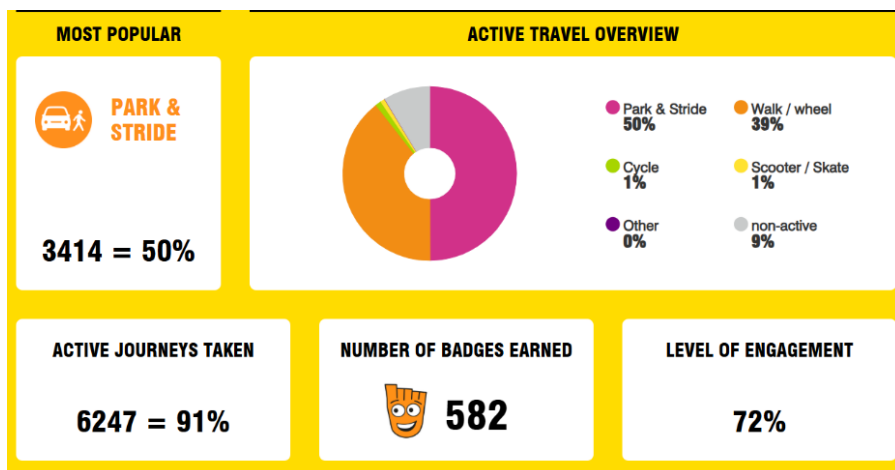
West Yorkshire School Games Cross Country Finals

Fruit Shop Payment for Summer Term 2026 *Yr. 3-6 Children Only*

If you would like your child to have fruit and healthy snacks from our Fruit Shop during the Summer Term 2026, would you please make a payment of £18.90 via your Parent Pay account no later than **9am 20th March 2026**. This represents a charge of 30p for 1 item every day from our Fruit Shop. Please note that your payment means that your child opts into our Fruit Shop for the full term and, due to the numbers and

logistics involved, we are unable to make refunds for absence, etc. Please note, children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 receive a snack as part of their Universal Free School Meals.

Please be aware that this is a **firm deadline**, once it has passed, we will be unable to add any children to the Fruit Shop list. In past years we have tried to accommodate late additions however due to the volume that we have recently experienced we will no longer be able to do so. We appreciate this may be an inconvenience to some parents but unfortunately it is no longer sustainable for the kitchen to keep up with the constant changes.

Plastic Bottle Recycling Challenge – Let’s Get Collecting!

Shout Out: Moorlands Marvel Award

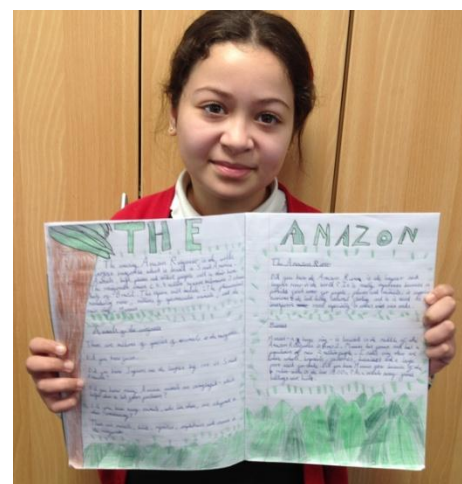

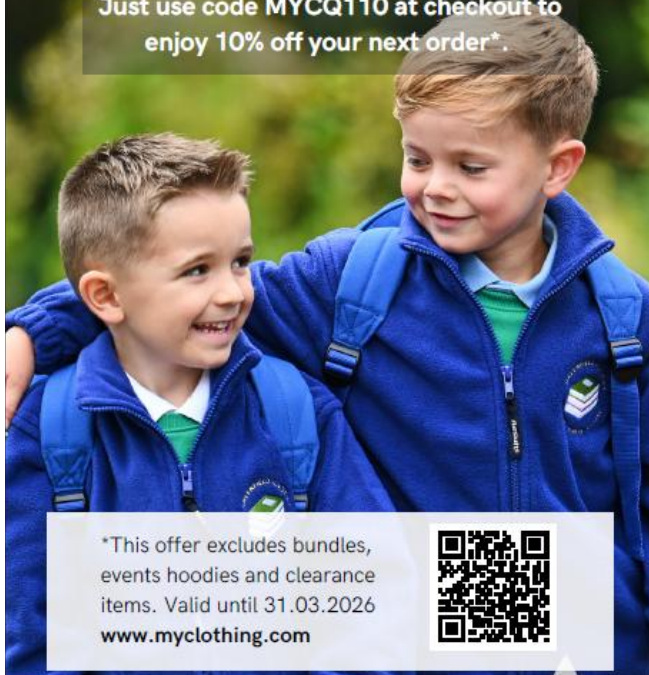
