Safety Rangers

Year 4 were very lucky to have a visit from a road safety expert, Letty, this week. During our interactive session, Letty helped the children to become Road Traffic Officers. Working together as a team, the children became collision investigators, using clues left behind at the scene of a road traffic accident. After discovering that both the driver and pedestrian involved in the accident were at fault, the children made

sensible suggestions as to how this kind of accident could be avoided in the future and discussed the role that they play as responsible pedestrians. They were reminded of 'STOP, LOOK, LISTEN, THINK' rules and acted out how to approach and crossroads in a safe manner.

Did you know that it takes a car travelling at 30mph the length of 6 cars to fully stop to avoid a collision? Let's all try our best to be safe when near dangerous roads, Year 4, and remember "only traffic belongs on the road".
